2. DISCUSSION:

A. CONSIDER APPROVAL OF INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT CREATING A BIOSCIENCE LAND PROTECTION ADVISORY BOARD

RESOLUTION NO. 30-06 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY THE CITY OF PALM BEACH GARDENS, MANGONIA PARK, THE TOWN OF LAKE PARK, AND THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH CREATING A BIOSCIENCE LAND PROTECTION ADVISORY BOARD AND PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF LOCAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENTS TO ESTABLISH AND PROTECT BIOSCIENCE RESEARCH PROTECTION OVERLAYS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
