A lengthy discussion ensued amongst the City Council and the developers. They commented on concerns expressed by the residents/business owners.

Members of the City Council and the Mayor expressed their concern regarding redeveloping the City.

Councilperson Wade stated the following for the record:

- she was in favor of redevelopment
- she did not know it included half of her district
- she would work hard to ensure the needs of the residents were met
- she had a fear that once the redevelopment area was established, that future Councils could come in and do whatever they wanted
- she stated that she would not be supporting this concept because of various discrepancies
