He further commented regarding consideration (payment) for the guest speaker, former-Mayor Maynard Jackson. He indicated that City Manager Wilkins could advise Council at the next meeting regarding the availability of promotional funds to allow the payment.

CONSIDERATION FOR REVIEW OF THE CITYWIDE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PLAN Mayor Brown

Mayor Brown commented regarding a consulting firm (Washington Economics Group/ J. Antonio Villamil). He indicated necessity of a road map for the City of Riviera Beach. He asked that Council consider the referenced firm at a negotiated fee or agreement at the meeting of January 03, 2001.

UPDATE ON CONGRESS AVENUE ACQUISITION. Mayor Brown

Mayor Brown commented regarding acquisition of the referenced property to develop a residential community. He then asked for an update from City Manager Wilkins.

City Manager Wilkins commented regarding efforts via the Police Pension Board to
