CANVASSING BOARD MEETING MINUTES
MUNICIPAL COMPLEX COUNCIL CHAMBERS
WEDNESDAY, MARCH 20, 2013 AT 5:00 P.M.**

(Everyone stood for a moment of silence after which the Pledge of Allegiance was recited).

CITY CLERK WARD: We will now proceed with the Resolution. Resolution 24 -- 20-13, a resolution of the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, declaring the results of the March 12, 2013 Municipal General Election held within the municipal boundaries between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. Reporting the results of the precinct summary voting system post-audit of Precinct Number 7022 in the District 5 race that was held March 18th at 10 a.m. For the name and the recipients in the Mayor's seat, City Council District 1, City Council District 3, and City Council District 5, respectively, and providing an effective date. Whereas on the 12th day of March, 2013, the municipal general election was held in the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing qualified candidates as provided for by law, in the Mayor's seat, City Council District 1, City Council District 3, and City Council District 5, and whereas the polling sites, precinct clerks, precinct inspectors, and precinct police officers of said elections held on March 12, 2013, were duly appointed and supervised by the Riviera Beach Supervisor of Elections, and whereas on March 12th, 2013, the 21 precinct clerks escorted by the precinct police officers, transported their results to the Riviera Beach Supervisor of Elections at the Municipal Complex for examination and exceptions to report the findings to the tabulating center, Palm Beach County warehouse located in Riviera Beach, and whereas upon transport the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections found election returns delivered by the Riviera Beach Supervisor of Elections from their 21 precincts to be true and accurate tabulations of the actual votes cast, to include provisional ballots, and immediately following verification of absentee ballots was completed; whereas, on the 18th day of March the City Council District 5 seat was selected for audit purpose, Precinct number 7022, there were no inconsistencies, declaring an accurate audit, the voting system post-election audit is attached. Now, therefore be it resolved upon final count of total votes cast, to include the canvassing of absentee ballots by the Riviera Beach Canvassing Board, the 2013 Riviera Beach election is final.

Section 2. Total registered voters, 22,464. Total ballots cast, 3,709. Percentage turnout was 61.51 percent. Absentee ballots total, 1,002. In the Mayor race, Billie Brooks received 1,219 votes. Shelby L. Lowe, 530 votes. Thomas Masters, 1,946 votes. City Council District 1, Bruce Guyton received 1,872 votes. Elizabeth Robinson, 1,691 votes. In City Council District 3, Cedrick Thomas received 2,697 votes. Rodney

Roberts, 917 votes. City Council District 5, Terrence T.D. Davis, 1,951 votes. Kimberly Jackson, 1,661 votes.

Be it further resolved, based on the results of the official certified statement of votes received from the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections, I hereby certify the results as final to the Riviera Beach Canvassing Board. That City Clerk is, and she is hereby directed to -- to provide election certificates and administer the oath of office in accordance with the City Charter and the laws of the State of Florida in their respective district.

COUNCILPERSON DAVIS: So moved.

CITY CLERK WARD: Mayor Thomas Masters, 1,946 votes as the Mayor. City Council District 1, Bruce Guyton with 1,872 votes. City Council District 3, Cedrick Thomas, 2,697 votes. City Council District 5, Terrence T.D. Davis, 1,951 votes.

COUNCILPERSON DAVIS: So moved.

COUNCILPERSON PARDO: Second.

CITY CLERK WARD: Will there be any comments?

COUNCILPERSON PARDO: No comments.

COUNCILPERSON DAVIS: No, none for me.


CITY CLERK WARD: Okay. All those in favor? (All vote aye). Okay. That motion approved. Any comments from anyone? The public? Meeting adjourned.


COUNCILPERSON DAVIS: Okay. Thank you.






