

Every 24 hours an estimated 7,000 people worldwide are infected with HIV, the virus that causes acquired immunodeficiency syndrome, better known as AIDS, which according to the National Center for Disease Control, AIDS is the second leading cause of death in Florida.

Also according to the CDC the growing number of African Americans with AIDS makes Blacks the racial/ethnic group most affected by HIV and the group most at risk for developing the disease because so many people infected with HIV are unaware of their status.

Heart, Health, and Healing Ministries, Inc or "Triple H" for short provides HIV testing at non-traditional and non clinical venues in Palm Beach County, including on local street corners to promote education, involvement, testing and treatment. As a result of their work, last year alone 'Triple H' was responsible for the testing and servicing of nearly 3000 residents in Palm Beach County.

In recognition of the National HIV/AIDS Testing Day on June 27, 2012, and in honor of numerous AIDS awareness activities and walks across the country, Triple H is hosting multiple HIV/AIDS Awareness Walks throughout the county, the first of which will be in Riviera Beach, Saturday, June 23, 2012. Therefore the Mayor is proclaiming June 23, 2012 as HIV/AIDS Awareness and Testing Day in the City of Riviera Beach.


