

ORDINANCE NO. 001UD

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 20, ENTITLED "UTILITIES", ARTICLE III, "WATER", DIVISION 2. ENTITLED "RATES AND CHARGES" BY REVISING SECTION 20-63 ENTITLED "RESIDENTIAL SERVICE CHARGE SCHEDULE", SECTION 20-64 ENTITLED "COMMERCIAL SERVICE CHARGE SCHEDULE", SECTION 20-66 ENTITLED "IRRIGATION METER SERVICE CHARGE SCHEDULE", AND SECTION 20-70 ENTITLED "BASIS FOR SCHEDULE CHARGES"; AND BY AMENDING AND UPDATING ARTICLE IV, ENTITLED "WASTEWATER DISPOSAL SYSTEM", DIVISION 2 ENTITLED "RATES AND CHARGES", BY REVISING AND UPDATING SECTION 20-183, ENTITLED "RESIDENTIAL SINGLE AND MULTIPLE UNIT SEWER SERVICE", AND SECTION 20-184 "COMMERCIAL AND HOTEL MOTEL SEWER RATE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the purpose of this proposed Ordinance is to set forth new water rates for fiscal years 2008-2009 through 2017-2018 and to amend Chapter 20 accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 20, Article III entitled "Water" "Division 2. Rates and Charges" is hereby deleted from the code of ordinances in its entirety and shall be maintained on file due to the length and context in the Office of the City Clerk. Sec. 20-70. Basis for schedule charges.

(a) Basis for commercial, hotel and motel readiness-to-serve charge. The readiness-to-serve charge for commercial consumers is based on the demand each commercial consumer can place on the utility system. A minimum of one ERU shall be charged to each commercial consumer. The usage charges are adjusted based on each commercial user's demand characteristics.

~~(b) *Basis for motel and hotel schedule.* A separate classification is for motels and hotels. The schedule of rates presents the motel/hotel rate structure. The readiness-to-serve charge is \$4.25 per unit with no distinction between the first and next units. Consumption will be billed at the inverse use rate table. The billings for the motel and hotel classification will be on the average consumption per unit.~~

~~(e) (b) *Mixed uses; multiple units.* Each unit of any building having separate units which are used for the housing of two or more families or for commercial purposes, or for both such purposes, and each trailer space of any trailer park shall be considered a unit. As in the case of storage bays, the number of units will be based on the number of water closets required under the Standard Building Code in relation to the number of bays. One water closet equals one unit. Where more than one meter serves a property, the rate is computed on the basis of each meter.~~

~~(d) (c) *Responsibility for usage.* The city will not be responsible for water usage after termination of service. All water that flows through the meter will be billed to the customer. The owner is responsible for the bill after a tenant's account is terminated by the city. The city can only guarantee no usage if a request in writing from the owner is made to the water department for the services to be removed. Upon requesting the services to be resumed, there will be a new connection charge.~~






