A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, UPDATING THE FURLOUGH POLICY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2011 – 2012 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, In order to balance the 2011 – 2012 Fiscal Year Budget, staff recommends approval of 12 unpaid furlough days for each full-time employee and one (1) day for hours worked per day for part-time and temporary employees in the 2011 – 2012 Budget; and

WHEREAS, City staff contacted the five (5) bargaining units to continue the furloughs; and

WHEREAS, the furlough policy was revised and the calendar of furlough days was created, said calendar to be amended from time to time by the City Manager, as necessary; and

WHEREAS, all employees, i.e. full, part-time, contractual, and temporary etc. will participate in the furlough; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Finance Director has indicated that the unpaid furlough days taken by employees will yield the City approximately nine hundred thousand dollars savings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Furlough Policy attached hereto, is hereby adopted by the City Council for Fiscal Year 2011 – 2012.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval for October 1, 2011.

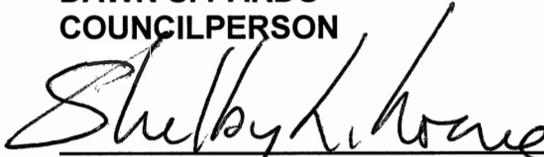

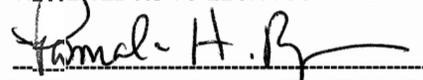

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE "INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEANUP" BY PARTICIPATING IN A CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN IN MONROE HEIGHTS AND THE SURROUNDING AREAS ON SEPTEMBER 17, 2011, SPONSORED BY OCEAN CONSERVANCY, COORDINATED BY KEEP PALM BEACH COUNTY BEAUTIFUL TO PROMOTE LITTER REDUCTION, SUPPORT RECYCLING, PRESERVE AND PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT AND HELP MAKE OUR NEIGHBORHOODS MORE LIVABLE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, protecting the integrity of the City's neighborhoods is vital to the stability and future growth of the City of Riviera Beach; and

WHEREAS, the International Coastal Cleanup organized in 1985 as an environmental study; the first volunteer driven cleanup occurred in 1986 and is now one of the largest international events; and

WHEREAS, the appearance and cleanliness of neighborhoods is a function of the integrity of those neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the city is partnering with Neighbors United in a national event sponsored by the Ocean Conservancy and focused on cleaning up coastal areas and waterways across the country in a national day of cleanup; and

WHEREAS, Councilperson Brooks, the City Council's representative for that district, Neighbors United and dozens of residents and volunteers will support those efforts by picking up trash and debris in the neighborhood of Monroe Heights and surrounding areas before it reaches our shorelines and waterways; and

WHEREAS, Councilperson Brooks and Neighbors United one of the most influential organization formed and founded over 13 years ago by Ms. Isabella Cunningham and other volunteers plan to continue their partnership in an effort to ensure other City neighborhoods are also kept litter free, vital and healthy.

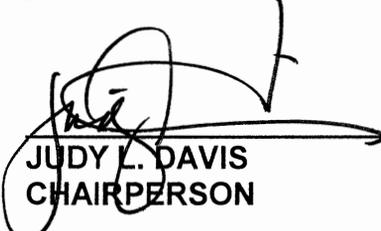

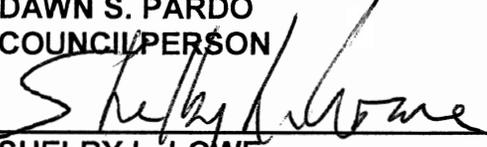

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW FORD RANGER EXTENDED CAB PICKUP TRUCK FROM HUB CITY FORD BY PIGGYBACKING ON THE FLORIDA SHERIFFS ASSOCIATION CONTRACT NUMBER 10-18-0907; AUTHORIZING THE INTERIM FINANCE DIRECTOR TO INCREASE THE PUBLIC WORKS BUDGET IN THE AMOUNT OF \$26,250 FOR PERSONNEL AND EQUIPMENT COSTS AND MAKING PAYMENT OF \$17,180.00 FOR THE VEHICLE PURCHASE FROM ACCOUNT 001-1123-534-0-6451; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City entered into a new solid waste collection agreement that requires the contractor to cover all expenses related to the Solid Waste Contract Compliance Officer position; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the department purchase a vehicle to be used by the Solid Waste Contract Compliance Officer utilizing funding provided by the contractor.

SECTION 2. The Interim Finance Director is authorized to increase the Public Works general fund budget for personnel and equipment in the amount of \$26,250.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment from Account No. 001-1123-534-0-6451 in the amount of \$17,180.00 for the purchase of the vehicle.
