SECTION 2. That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment of \$20,220 from account number 001-1336-571-0-6101.

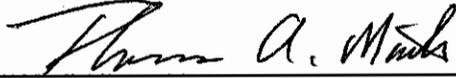

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT TO MAKE PAYMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$6,200.00 TO PROMOTIONAL CONSULTING UNLIMITED AS PAYMENT FOR PROVIDING SERVICE AND TESTING MATERIALS FOR THE RANK OF POLICE COMMANDER; AND PROVIDING AN ADDITIONAL PAYMENT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,100.00 FOR A TOTAL OF SIX (6) CANDIDATES TESTING AT A COST OF \$350.00 FOR EACH CANDIDATE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Promotional Consulting Unlimited is the most cost effective and reliable vendor for promotional public safety testing; and

WHEREAS, there is a \$10,000.00 limit on the amount of money that can be paid to any one vendor during a budget year without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, the same vendor also provided testing service for the rank of Police Sergeant in March 2010 amounting to \$6,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Promotional Consulting Unlimited will create and administer the test for Police Commander September 10, 2010 in the amount of \$6,200.00; and

WHEREAS, upon administering the test on September 10, 2010, the City shall pay \$350.00 per employee not to exceed the six (6) lieutenants of police who have requested to take the test.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Interim Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Promotional Consulting Unlimited in the amount of \$6,200.00 and an additional cost not to exceed \$2,100.00 upon receipt of an invoice for the number of candidates testing on September 10, 2010, at a cost of \$350.00 for each candidate.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the City Council.

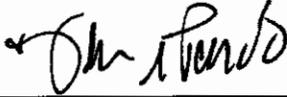

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, UPDATING THE FURLOUGH POLICY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 – 2011 AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, In order to balance the 2010 – 2011 Fiscal Year Budget, staff recommends approval of 12 unpaid furlough days for each full time employee and one (1) day for hours worked per day for part time and temporary employees in the 2010 – 2011 Budget; and

WHEREAS, City staff contacted the five (5) bargaining units to continue the furloughs; and

WHEREAS, the furlough policy was revised and the calendar of furlough days was created, said calendar to be amended from time to time by the City Manager, as necessary; and

WHEREAS, all employees, i.e. full, part-time, contractual, and temporary etc, will participate in the furlough; and

WHEREAS, the Interim Finance Director has indicated that the unpaid furlough days taken by employees will yield the City approximately a million dollar savings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the Furlough Policy attached hereto, is hereby adopted by the City Council for Fiscal Year 2010 – 11.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect upon its passage and approval for October 1, 2010.

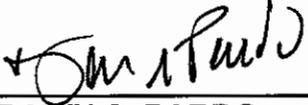

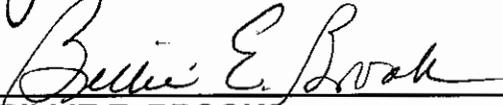

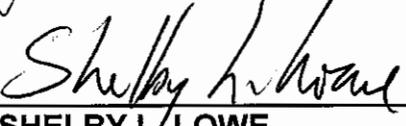

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AWARDED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH O'BRIEN'S RESPONSE MANAGEMENT INC., OF MAITLAND, FLORIDA BY PIGGYBACKING FROM COOPER CITY RFP #2009-7 TO PROVIDE DEBRIS MONITORING SERVICES ON AN AS-NEEDED BASIS AS MAYBE REQUIRED BY THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City needs to insure it is adequately prepared to effectively respond to potential future needs for debris monitoring services required to qualify for state and federal reimbursement of debris removal cost associated with declared disasters; and.

WHEREAS, The Purchasing Department has identified a qualified company to provide debris monitoring services: O'Brien's Response Management Inc, on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, does hereby accept the Purchasing Department's recommendation and approves the piggyback agreement for debris monitoring services.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Finance Director are authorized to make payment from the appropriate accounts.

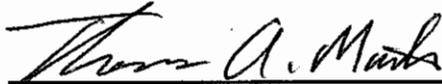

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN VIKING DEVELOPERS, LLC, AND SUB-DEVELOPER, RYBOVICH RIVIERA BEACH LLC, AS IT RELATES TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF CERTAIN PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY'S MARINA DISTRICT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Riviera Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA), the City of Riviera Beach (City), and Viking Developers, LLC (Viking), are parties to a Master Development Agreement relating to the redevelopment of certain property located within the Marina District at the City of Riviera Beach's marina; and

WHEREAS, the CRA and City accepted and approved an amended Conceptual Master Development Plan, which was comprised of nineteen (19) separate project elements, at duly called public meetings held on February 10, 2010, and February 17, 2010 respectively; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Master Development Agreement, Viking retained the right to transfer and assign development rights to another bona fide developer for some or all of the project elements, subject to acceptance and approval by the City and the CRA; and

WHEREAS, Viking desires to assign certain portions of development of the Conceptual Master Development Plan to Rybovich Riviera Beach LLC, as more particularly defined in the assignment agreement.

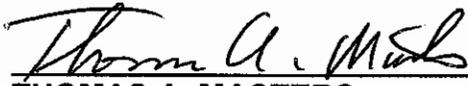

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE A 25 YEAR SUBMERGED AND UPLAND LANDS LEASE WITH RYBOVICH RIVIERA BEACH LLC, THE RIVIERA BEACH COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AND THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH UTILITY SPECIAL DISTRICT; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO FACILITATE THE TERMS OF THE LEASE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Riviera Beach Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) and the City of Riviera Beach (City) seek to redevelop certain property located within the Marina District pursuant to the City's Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, the property is located in the Marina District bordered to the east by the Intracoastal waterway, bordered to the west by Broadway/U.S. Highway 1, bordered to the south by East 11th Street and bordered to the north by East 15th Street and the northern boundary of Bicentennial Park; and includes the City marina docks and uplands, and additional property that includes streets, sidewalks, parking areas, improved and unimproved land, and recreation areas; and

WHEREAS, the CRA and City accepted and approved an amended Conceptual Master Development Plan, which is currently comprised of eighteen (18) separate project elements, at duly called public meetings held on February 10, 2010, and February 17, 2010 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the CRA, the City, and Viking Developers, LLC (Viking), are parties to a Master Development Agreement relating to the redevelopment of property located within the Marina District as set out in the Conceptual Master Development Plan; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Master Development Agreement, Viking retained the right to transfer and assign development rights to another bona fide developer for some or all of the project elements, subject to acceptance and approval by the City and the CRA; and

WHEREAS, Viking exercised its right and assigned the development of portions of the Conceptual Master Development Plan, specifically portions of what is referred to as Elements 13, 14, and 15 to Rybovich Riviera Beach LLC (Rybovich), with the City's and CRA's approval; and

WHEREAS, the City and CRA authorized staff to negotiate an agreement with Rybovich to facilitate the development of portions of Elements 13, 14, and 15; and

WHEREAS, the City and CRA have negotiated a 25 year Lease with Rybovich to lease approximately 121,050 square feet of upland land and approximately 164,389 square feet of submerged land, subject to certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that by entering into the Lease, it will facilitate increased revenue to the city and it will be beneficial to tourism and recreation by providing additional services, jobs, retail opportunities and economic development in the waterfront area of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, a 25 year Submerged and Upland Lands Lease with Rybovich Riviera Beach LLC, the CRA, and the City of Riviera Beach Utility Special District. Said Lease is attached hereto.

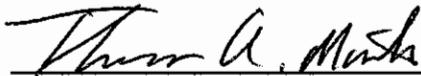
SECTION 2. The City Manager is authorized to take all actions necessary to facilitate the terms of the Lease, including applying for grants and making payments as contemplated by the Lease.

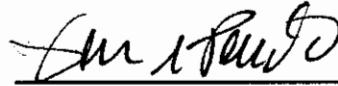

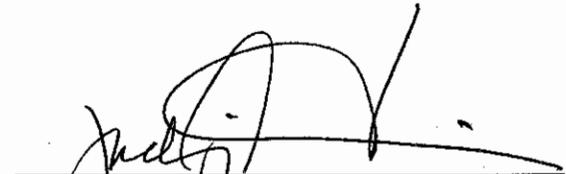

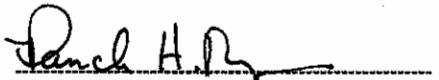

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach is in need of placing its health Insurance with a carrier; and

WHEREAS, an RFP was placed and four (4) responses were received; and

WHEREAS, interviews were held with the two (2) lowest bidders; and

WHEREAS, several review sessions were held including a workshop with City Council; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends placing the City's health insurance coverage with Coventry Health Care of Florida Inc.; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends a three (3) tier insurance plan for the 2010-2011 policy year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

SECTION 1. That staff is hereby authorized to bind coverage for the City of Riviera Beach for health insurance coverage with Coventry Health Care of Florida Inc. to provide medical insurance for City employees for the Policy Year 2010-2011.

SECTION 2. That the Interim Finance Director is authorized to make payment for the City's contribution to the health insurance costs from various City departmental accounts in the estimated amount of \$3,731,875.20 for health insurance.

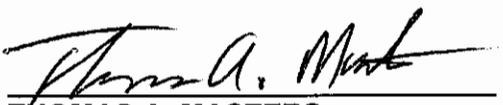

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE "INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEANUP" CAMPAIGN BY HOSTING A CLEAN-UP IN THE MONROE HEIGHTS NEIGHBORHOOD AND A CLEANUP OF THE CITY'S SOUTH END NEIGHBORHOOD ON SEPTEMBER 25, 2010; THE INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEANUP IS AN ANNUAL EVENT SPONSORED BY THE OCEAN CONSERVANCY AND IS HELD ON THE 3RD SATURDAY IN SEPTEMBER TO PROMOTE LITTER REDUCTION, SUPPORT RECYCLING, PRESERVE AND PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT TO HELP MAKE OUR NEIGHBORHOODS MORE LIVABLE, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, protecting the integrity of the City's neighborhoods is vital to the stability and future growth of the City of Riviera Beach; and

WHEREAS, the International Coastal Cleanup began in 1985 as an environmental study. The first volunteer driven cleanup occurred in 1986 and is now one of the largest international volunteer events; and

WHEREAS, the ICC allows citizens around the world an opportunity to clean up their local water ways and to be a part of a large organized annual event; and

WHEREAS, the ICC encourages local environmental non-profit and agencies to spotlight environmental issues and to promote community ownership throughout; and

WHEREAS, Neighbors United of Riviera Beach was formed and founded over 12 years ago by Ms. Isabella Cunningham as an effort to promote and excite cleanup efforts in the surrounding neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Neighbors United has grown over the past years and as a result of the vast growth, Ms. Willie Daniels serves as the president; and

WHEREAS, for the past 8 years, Mrs. Bernice Wooten has served and is the site coordinator for Neighbors United, wherein she is responsible for organizing and coordinating efforts for the neighborhoods cleanup.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:

SECTION 1. Members of the City Council expressed concerns about the quality of life for all of its residents and Councilperson Billie Brooks and Councilperson Cedrick Thomas began working with neighborhood groups, city residents, employees and volunteers on ways to clean up neighborhoods, beginning in Monroe Heights and the South End.

SECTION 2. Councilpersons Brooks and Thomas are joining thousands of others across the county and across the country in a national day of cleanup being sponsored by the Ocean Conservancy and organized locally by the non-profit "Keep Palm Beach County Beautiful, Inc.," an affiliate of the national "Keep America Beautiful" campaign.

SECTION 3. The Coastal Cleanup annual event focus is on waterways, there is recognition that picking up trash in inland neighborhoods to help prevent it from traveling to coastal areas and waterways.

SECTION 4. Councilperson Brooks and Councilperson Thomas are hosts of this event to push the importance and value of clean neighborhoods.

SECTION 5. The City Council hereby supports the "Keep America Beautiful" campaign and authorizes the cleanup of Monroe Heights and the City's South End neighborhoods as part of the "International Coastal Cleanup" as planned from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. on Saturday, September 25, 2010.

SECTION 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and adoption.
