SECTION 2: The City Council authorizes the funding of said proposal through the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF).

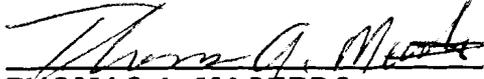

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL TO APPROVE AN INTER-LOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN PALM BEACH COUNTY AND THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH AND ACCEPTING REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS FROM PALM BEACH COUNTY INTO POLICE BUDGET ACCOUNT NO. 001-00-342290 POLICE MARINE SERVICES SALARIES FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES RENDERED FOR MARINE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, a Inter-local Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between Palm Beach County and Riviera Beach Police Department will be entered on November 15, 2008 - March 31, 2011; and

WHEREAS, this agreement provides the opportunity for additional marine law enforcement services within estuarine waters of the County during manatee season; and

WHEREAS, approving this contract will authorize the Riviera Beach Police Department to supply Officer(s) labor, supervision, equipment (included BUT not limited to vessel insurance and necessary supplies to carry out the agreement; and

WHEREAS, Palm Beach County will be authorized to reimburse the City of Riviera Beach for law enforcement services at a rate of \$82.50 per hour for on the water enforcement activity; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Council approves the Inter-local Agreement between Palm Beach County and Riviera Beach Police Department, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the same.

SECTION 3: The Finance Director is authorized to set up an account to receive reimbursement for services rendered for Marine Law Enforcement.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY INCREASE OF THE COMPLEMENT OF SERGEANTS FROM TWELVE (12) TO FIFTEEN (15) UNTIL SEPTEMBER 30, 2009, AT WHICH TIME THE THREE TEMPORARY SERGEANT POSITIONS CREATED BY THIS ACTION WILL BE ELIMINATED; AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO FUND SAID POSITIONS THROUGH THE ATTRITION OF PERSONNEL; AND AUTHORIZING A BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$5,938.56 FROM OVERTIME ACCOUNT 001-0822-521-0-1203 TO REGULAR SALARIES ACCOUNT 001-0822-521-0-1201, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Police Department has an established complement of 116 sworn police officers which includes twelve (12) members at the rank of sergeants; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department is requesting to temporarily increase the complement of sergeants to fifteen (15) until September 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the attrition of personnel and a budget transfer of \$5,938.56 from the Overtime line to the Regular Salaries line will permit the Police Department to fund the additional sergeants from the existing FY2008 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City Council approves the temporary increase in the complement of Police Sergeants to fifteen (15) until September 30, 2009, at which time the three (3) temporary sergeant positions created by this action will be eliminated.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A NEW FIFTY YEAR LEASE AGREEMENT WITH THE BOYS AND GIRLS CLUBS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LEASE AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Clubs of Palm Beach County, Inc. (hereinafter "Boys and Girls Club") is a not-for-profit entity providing valuable youth development services within the City of Riviera Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Boys and Girls Club are currently parties to a Lease Agreement dated January 17, 1996, pursuant to which the Boys and Girls Club is the tenant of certain real property located in the City of Riviera Beach, having an address at 200 West 13th Street, Riviera Beach, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Boys and Girls Club desires to continue leasing the existing premises pursuant to the covenants and conditions of the current Lease pending the design and construction of new facilities on certain premises owned by the City located contiguous to the existing premises; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Boys and Girls Club desire to set forth the covenants, provisions and conditions pursuant to which the Boys and Girls Club shall lease from the City said contiguous premises, to be used solely and exclusively for recreational, educational and youth development purposes or other public purposes as permitted herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public to enter into this new Lease with the Boys and Girls Club.

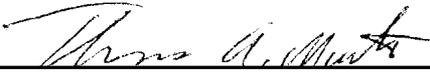
SECTION 1. That the new fifty (50) year Lease Agreement with the Boys and Girls Club is hereby approved.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING A NEW ONE YEAR LEASE WITH THE RIVIERA BEACH MARITIME ACADEMY CORPORATION AT \$500 PER MONTH; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LEASE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Maritime Academy improved the site with temporary portables and landscaping and has operated a successful charter school at the site; and

WHEREAS, the Maritime Academy has been operating in a month to month fashion with the lease agreement since the lease expired in August 2008, and is requesting that the City grant an additional one year lease; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the city to enter into a new one year lease with the Maritime Academy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That a new one year lease with the Maritime Academy at \$500 per month is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and City Clerk are authorized to execute the lease on behalf of the City, said Lease is attached hereto.

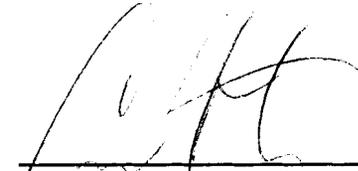

RESOLUTION NO. 145-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT FROM PALM BEACH COUNTY - OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE COMMISSION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$16,500; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO ESTABLISH A BUDGET; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.01, Florida Statutes, known as the "Florida Interlocal Cooperation act of 1969" authorizes local governments to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities that will harmonize geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach has an investment in the Civil Drug Court and has since its inception in 1991; and

WHEREAS, the County's Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), wishes to provide continued support to the Civil Drug Court to provide services to citizens who are affected by substance abuse and addiction; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Drug Court acknowledges that participation by the family in treatment and recovery process via family counseling, participation in group counseling, and an opportunity for increased knowledge of the recovery process will assist the family in supporting the substance abuser; and

WHEREAS, through the continued pairing of clients with social service agencies, continued identification of employment and adequate housing needs; restored family relationships and completion of educational requirements for the clients, success of the program will be realized. Additionally, success will also be realized when a client had completed the 60 day court ordered treatment program, followed by a 90 day aftercare service and random drug testing to insure program compliance and completion for the client; and

WHEREAS, the continued long term goals are to increase active family participation in the recovery and treatment process including individual, group, and family counseling; and

WHEREAS, on the recommendation of the CJC, the services of the Family Restart Complete Care Program are needed to arrange and provide services to the families of the Civil Drug Court clients.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the City Council authorizes the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the interlocal agreement with the County accepting \$16,500 to provide support for the services of the Family Restart Complete Care Program specifically listed in the Scope of Work, Exhibit "A".

SECTION 2: That the Finance Director is authorized to set up budget as follows:

REVENUE
