SUPERINTENDENT OF VEHICLE MAINTENANCE

Definition:

This is responsible technical work supervising the activities of the Vehicle Maintenance Division in the Public Works Department.

The employee in this class is responsible for scheduling and supervising the maintenance and repair of city vehicles. General direction is received from the Superintendent of General Maintenance, but the employee is expected to work independently in carrying out assignments. Work is reviewed through observation of results obtained and through periodic reports and conferences.

Examples of Work Performed:

Schedules and supervises the maintenance and repair of all city vehicles.

Assigns personnel to cover vacancies as necessary.

Maintains records of operation and prepares routine and special reports as required.

Advises the Purchasing Division on types of vehicles and replacement parts required.

Performs related work as required.

Required Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of principles, practices, equipment and materials used in the maintenance of various municipal vehicles.

Some knowledge of the principles of records maintenance and report preparation.

Some knowledge of purchasing specifications and practices related to vehicles.

Ability to supervise and assist subordinate employees engaged in the maintenance of city vehicles.

Ability to communicate both orally and in writing.

Minimum Experience and Training:

Graduation from high school and four (4) years experience in all phases of the repair of motor vehicles, at least one year of which shall have been in a supervisory position; or any equivalent combination of training and experience.

"(1) Invest the assets of the police officers' retirement trust fund as authorized by said Chapter 185, Florida Statutes, 1955, as amended, except the board of trustees may invest not more than 3 percent of its assets in the common stock or capital stock of any one issuing company, nor exceed 3 percent of the outstanding capital stock of that company, nor shall the aggregate of its investments at cost exceed 30 percent of the assets of the fund."
