

ORDINANCE NO. 2200

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ARTICLE II OF THE CHARTER BY REVISING THE SALARIES OF THE ELECTED OFFICIALS FROM \$2,400. to \$ 6,000. , PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. A public hearing first being held as provided for in Section 1 of Ordinance 2192, Section 12 of Article II of the Charter is amended by revising the salaries of elected officials from \$2,400. to \$ 6,000. , commencing the 1st day of July , 1983.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1.8 entitled "General penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2202

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING DIVISION 2 ENTITLED "CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD" OF ARTICLE IV. ENTITLED "ENFORCEMENT OF ORDINANCES" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REVISING SAME PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 162, FLORIDA STATUTES, ENTITLED "COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CODE ENFORCEMENT" AS AMENDED, 1982; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The Sections herein designated of Division 2, Article IV of Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances are revised as follows:

"Sec. 2-36.2. Applicability; jurisdiction.

- (c) Ordinances and regulations: Building, Fire and Sign

"Sec. 2-36.3. Creation of board; organization; qualifications; terms of office; officers.

- (a) The city council shall appoint a ~~six~~ seven member code enforcement board and legal counsel for the board.
- (b) (2) ~~Two (2)~~ Three (3) members shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years.
- (d) The city attorney shall be counsel to the enforcement board. The city prosecutor shall represent the City of Riviera Beach by representing cases before the board, but in no case shall the city attorney serve in both capacities.

"Sec. 2-36.5. Enforcement procedures.

- (a) It shall be the duty of the code inspector to initiate enforcement proceedings of the various codes, however, no member of the board shall have the power to initiate such enforcement proceedings.
- (b) If a violation of the codes is found, the code inspector shall notify the violator, unless paragraph (c) of this section applies, and gives said violator a reasonable time to correct the violation.

"Sec. 2-36.6. Conduct of hearings.

- (a) The chairperson of the enforcement board may call hearings of the enforcement board and hearings may also be called by written notice signed by at

least ~~four-(4)~~ three (3) members of the enforcement board. The enforcement board at any hearing may set a future hearing date. The enforcement board shall attempt to convene no less frequently than ~~once-a month~~ every two (2) months, but may meet more or less often as the demand necessitates.

- (e) At the conclusions of the enforcement board hearings, said board shall issue findings of fact and conclusions of law and shall issue a written order affording the relief consistent with powers granted herein. The findings and conclusions shall be by motion approved by a majority of those members present and voting, except that at least ~~three-(3)~~ four (4) members of the enforcement board must vote for the action to be official.

" Sec. 2-36.7. Appeal.

An aggrieved party, including the city, may appeal a final ruling or written order of the enforcement board by certiorari to the circuit court ~~of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit in and for Palm Beach County.~~

"Sec. 2-36.8. Fines.

The enforcement board, upon notification by the city prosecutor that a previous order of the enforcement board has not been complied with in the set time, may order the violator to pay a fine not to exceed ~~five hundred dollars-(\$500.00)~~ two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) per day if the violation continues past the date set for compliance. A certified copy of an order imposing a fine may be recorded in the public records of Palm Beach County, and shall constitute a lien against the land on which the violation exists, or, if the violator does not own the land, upon any other real or personal property owned by the violator; and it may be enforced in the same manner as a court judgment by the sheriffs of this state, including levy against the personal property, but shall not be deemed to be a court judgment except for enforcement purposes. After one year from the filing of any such lien which remains unpaid, the enforcement board may authorize the city attorney to foreclose on the lien.

"Sec. 2-36.9. Notices.

All notices required by this division shall be certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the violator's last known address of record or by hand delivery by the code inspector, ~~or a police officer~~, where mail would not be effective.

"Sec. 2.36.10. Duration of lien.

No lien provided under the Local Government Code Enforcement Boards Act shall continue for a period longer than 2 years after the certified copy of an

order imposing a fine has been recorded, unless within that time an action to foreclose on the lien is commenced in a court of competent jurisdiction. The continuation of the lien effected by the commencement of the action shall not be good against creditors or subsequent purchasers for valuable consideration without notice, unless a notice of lis pendens is recorded.

"Sec. 2.36.11. Provisions of act supplemental.

It is the legislative intent of ss. 162.01 - 162.12 to provide an additional or supplemental means of obtaining compliance with local codes. Nothing contained in ss. 162.01 - 162.12 shall prohibit a local governing body from enforcing its codes by any other means.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1.8 entitled "General penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.
