

ORDINANCE NO. 2350

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3, OF SECTION 2-100 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA RELATING TO RATES OF PAY AND SALARY SCHEDULE BE AMENDED BY CREATING THE CLASSIFIED POSITIONS OF PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND LEGAL ASSISTANT UNDER CLASS TITLES POLICE (NON-SWORN) AND ADMINISTRATIVE, GENERAL RESPECTIVELY; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Article VI, Division 3, of Section 2-100 of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach, relating to rates of pay and salary schedule be amended by creating the classified positions as follows:

POLICE (NON-SWORN)	PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER	G24
ADMINISTRATIVE, GENERAL	LEGAL ASSISTANT	G31

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1-8, entitled, "General Penalty", of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Chapter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provisions or applications of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications thereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3, OF SECTION 2-100 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA RELATING TO RATES OF PAY AND SALARY SCHEDULE BY REGRADING THE UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF ASSISTANT FINANCE DIRECTOR UNDER CLASS TITLE FINANCE AND ACCOUNTING, PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE I, SECTIONS 14-2, 14-3, 14-4.1(1), 14-4.3 AND 14-4.6(1); REPEALING SECTIONS 14-4.6(2) AND (3); OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA RELATING TO PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT OF FIREMEN; PROVIDING FOR AN ACTUARIAL EVALUATION EVERY THREE YEARS; PROVIDING FOR PAYMENTS EQUAL TO THE ACTUARIAL DEFICIENCY OR DEFICIENCIES AT LEAST QUARTERLY THROUGHOUT THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE FUND, WITH THE FIRST PAYMENT DUE ON OR PRIOR TO JANUARY 1 OF EACH YEAR; PROVIDING FOR A BOARD OF TRUSTEES; PROVIDING FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT FOR DISABILITY INCURRED WHILE IN THE LINE OF DUTY; PROVIDING FOR AN INTEREST RATE TO BE PAID ON REFUNDED CONTRIBUTIONS; AND DELETING SURPLUS LANGUAGE AND LANGUAGE OF QUESTIONABLE VALIDITY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. The second paragraph of Section 14-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The municipal treasurer is hereby authorized to withdraw from the general fund of the municipality a sum equal to the net annual cost and the amount required to fund over a period of not longer than forty years, and any actuarial deficiency shown by a triennial actuarial evaluation. The first such actuarial evaluation shall be conducted for the calendar year ending December 31, 1986.

Section 2. The third paragraph of Section 14-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The city finance director shall deliver to the Riviera Beach Municipal Firemen's Pension Trust Fund a sum of money, each year, equal to the actuarial deficiency or deficiencies as described above. These payments shall be made at least quarterly throughout the plan year of the trust fund, with the first payment due on or prior to March 31 of the year to which the actuarial evaluation applies.

Section 3. The first unnumbered paragraph of Section 14-3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is hereby created a board of trustees of the municipal firemen's pension trust fund. The board of trustees shall consist of five (5) members, two (2) of whom, shall be legal residents of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, who shall be appointed by the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, and two (2) of whom shall be full-time firefighters as defined in Section 175.032(1), Florida Statutes, who shall be elected by a majority of the firefighters who are members of the plan. The fifth member shall be chosen by a majority of the previous four (4) members

as provided for herein, and such person's name shall be submitted to the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida. Upon receipt of the fifth person's name, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida shall, as a ministerial duty, appoint such person to the board of trustees as its fifth member. The fifth member shall have the same rights as each of the other four (4) members appointed or elected as herein provided and may succeed himself in office. Each resident member shall serve as a trustee for a period of two (2) years from October 1, 1986, unless sooner replaced by the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, at whose pleasure he shall serve, and may succeed himself as a trustee. Each firefighter member shall serve as a trustee for a period of two (2) years from October 1, 1986, unless he sooner leaves the employment of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida as a firefighter, whereupon the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida shall choose his successor in the same manner as an original appointment. Each firefighter may succeed himself in office. The board of trustees shall meet at least quarterly each year. The board of trustees shall be a legal entity with, in addition to other powers and responsibilities contained herein, the power to bring and defend lawsuits of every kind, nature and description. The trustees shall by a majority vote elect a chairman and a secretary. The secretary of the board shall keep a complete minute book of the actions, proceedings or hearings of the board. The trustees shall not receive any compensation as such, but may receive expenses and per diem as provided by law. The board of trustees may:

Section 4. Section 14-4.1(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (1) If a fireman is totally disabled while in the line of duty, he shall be eligible for disability retirement.

Section 5. Section 14-4.3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Should a fireman leave the service of the municipality as a fireman, such fireman shall be entitled to a refund of all his contributions paid to the Riviera Beach Municipal Firemen's Pension Trust Fund, with interest. Said rate of interest shall be five and one-half (5.5%) per cent per annum, simple interest. A refund of contributions shall be in lieu of any other benefits to which a member may otherwise be entitled.

Section 6. Section 14-4.6(1) is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (1) The amount of the monthly retirement income benefit payable to a fireman who retired at age fifty (50) after twenty (20) years of service, and the contribution of eight (8) per cent of his annual salary to the Riviera Beach Municipal Firemen's Pension Trust Fund from the date of October 21, 1981, or from the date of his employment if hired at a later date, shall be three (3) per cent of the number of years of his credited service times the amount of his final average monthly compensation.

Section 7. Sections 14-4.6(2) and 14-4.6(3) are hereby repealed.

Section 8. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.






