

ORDINANCE NO. 2366

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 23.AA ENTITLED "ZONING" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH BY ENACTING A NEW SECTION 23.AA - 27.5 "LAND DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION FEES" TO PROVIDE A FEE SCHEDULE FOR LAND DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS AND PROCEDURES, BY AMENDING SUBSECTION 23.AA - 27 II "SPECIAL EXCEPTION" TO REFERENCE APPLICATION FEE, PROVIDING PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY AT A LATER DATE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Chapter 166.201 FS. provides that a municipality may assess uses charges of fees authorized by ordinances, which are necessary for the conduct of municipal government, and

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach provides considerable staff expertise and time for the review of development activities, and

WHEREAS, there is increasing complexity of review of said activities to insure protection of the public health, safety, and welfare and

WHEREAS, after review of the services provided a fee schedule has been structured and

WHEREAS, after Public Hearing the City Council has determined the fee schedule to be fair and reasonable

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

SECTION 1. That a new section 23.AA - 27.5 "Land Development Applicaton Fees" of Chapter 23.AA "Zoning" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Riviera Beach is hereby enacted as contained in appendix A and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That subparagraph "3" of subsection 23.AA - 27,II. "Special Exception", Paragraph B. "Procedures" is amended to include the sentence: For application fee see Section 27.AA - 5.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in section 1.8 entitled "General Penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or chapter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 5. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provision and applications hereof shall not be therefore affected.

SECTION 6. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this ordinance at a later date, together with the entire Land Development Code upon its completion.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption.

ORDINANCE NO. 2367

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH FLORIDA, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING RIVIERA BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES SECTION 1-8, GENERAL PENALTY CLAUSE TO PROVIDE FOR PROBATION, CONDITIONS OF PROBATION, AND AS PUNISHMENT AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF PROVISION OF THE RIVIERA BEACH CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach recognizes the rehabilitative effects of probation; and

WHEREAS, conditions of probation, such as community service; medical examinations; drug screening and treatment; and counseling, help to deter future violations of laws as well as promote public welfare, health and safety; and

WHEREAS the purpose of penalty for Code violators includes deterrence and rehabilitation as well as punishment;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida as follows:

SECTION 1 Riviera Beach Code of Ordinance Section 1-8 is amended to provide as follows.

(a) Whenever in this Code any act is prohibited or is declared to be unlawful or an offense, or whenever in Code the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, where no specific penalty is provided therefor; the violation of any such provision of this Code shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00); probation; conditions of probation, including but not limited to community service, drug screening and recommended treatment, medical examination, counseling, restitution; and/or imprisonment for a term not exceeding sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each day any violation of any provision of this Code shall constitute a separate offense.

(b) Whenever in this Code any act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense, or whenever in such Code the doing of any act is required

for failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful in addition to specific penalty provided therefor, the violation of any such provision of this Code shall be punished by probation; conditions of probation, including but not limited to community service, drug screening and evaluation, medical examination, home confinement, counseling, restitution, or a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars(\$500.00) or imprisonment for a term not exceeding sixty (60) days, or by all of the above penalties. Each day any violation of any provision of this Code shall continue, shall constitute a separate offense.

(c) In addition to the penalties hereinabove provided, any condition caused or permitted to exist in violation of any of the provisions of this Code shall be deemed a public nuisance and may be, by the municipality, abated as provided by law, and each day that such condition continues shall be regarded as a new and separate offense.

(d) When there exists no such provision by ordinance, the court shall proceed to punish such offense by probation, conditions of probation which promote rehabilitation and deterrence, seek retribution, obtain restitution, and result in forfeiture of illegal items or contraband.

SECTION 2. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this ordinance.







AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3, OF SECTION 2-100 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA, RELATING TO RATES OF PAY AND SALARY SCHEDULE BY DELETING THE CLASSIFIED POSITION OF DOCKMASTER UNDER CLASS TITLE MARINA, GENERAL; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Article VI, Division 3, of Section 2-100 of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach, Florida relating to rates of pay and salary schedule is amended by deleting the classified position:

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1-8 entitled "GENERAL PENALTY" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provisions or applications of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications thereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

DOCKMASTER
CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH

MAJOR FUNCTION

Responsible for supervisory work directing activities at the Municipal Marina and related facilities. Employee in this class is responsible for the management, operation and maintenance of a yacht marina which includes dockage, selling fuel, rental of boats and various concessions.

ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

Register all boats using facilities, assign slips for overnight boaters, collect fees and rentals, turn in monies collected to Marina Director.

Plan, assign and direct marina personnel engaged in activities including dockage, may pilot boats to locations.

Supervise the use of mooring facilities, recommend needed changes.

Direct policing operation of docks and facilities, keep water free from debris.

Act as collection agent for dockage rentals, concessions.

Plan and prepare departmental budget and operational reports

Direct and assist in the maintenance of buildings and facilities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Thorough knowledge of general boat handling, mooring, and docking practices and regulations applicable to the operation and use of marina facilities. Considerable knowledge of city ordinances and regulations governing the use of the marina facilities and waterways. Knowledge of modern office methods, equipment and procedures. Knowledge of standard safety precautions and first aid procedures. Ability to supervise the work of boat servicing and clerical assistants. Ability to maintain records and prepare reports. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with boat men, concessionaires, departmental officials and the general public.

Training and Experience: High school education supplemented by advanced training in business management and considerable experience with boats and boat handling, including some experience in the management of a marina or boatyard; or an equivalent combination of training and experience. Must possess valid State of Florida driver's license.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2 Article VI, Division 3 of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach, relating to rates of pay and salary schedule be amended by creating the unclassified position as follows:

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provisions or applications of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications thereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF MARINA
CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH

MAJOR FUNCTION

This is a responsible administrative and supervisory work assisting the Marina Director in coordinating the activities at the municipal marina and related facilities. The employee is responsible for assisting in the overall management, operation and maintenance of a yacht marina which includes dockage, selling fuel, dry dock commodation and ancillary services. Work is performed under general direction of the Marina Director.

ILLUSTRATIVE DUTIES

Assist in planning, organizing, and coordinating the work of the Municipal Marina. Assist in the direction of marina personnel engaged in dockage and servicing various types and sizes of water craft.

Assist in preparation of the annual budget of the department.

Recommend policy, rule, regulation and rate changes to the Director.

Assist the Director in providing suitable training to subordinate personnel.

Assign rental boat slips according to established procedures and maintain comprehensive records relating to such assignments. Collect monthly rental fees and ancillary monies and deliver to proper source. Maintain current records and provide periodic reports as required by the Marina Director.

Assign private, charter and other craft to adequate docking facilities and provide services such as gas and supplies to same.

Assist in maintenance of facilities and buildings.

Perform additional duties as required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Knowledge, Abilities and Skills: Thorough knowledge of general boat handling, mooring, and docking practices and regulations applicable to the operation and use of marina facilities. Wet and dry marina experience, good working knowledge of boat operation.

Knowledge of standard safety precautions and first aid procedures.

Ability to supervise the work of boat servicing and clerical assistants.

Ability to maintain records and prepare reports.

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with boatmen, concessionaires, and the general public.

TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Graduation from high school and associate degree from an accredited institution and considerable years of experience in marina or closely related marina business; or an equivalent combination of training and experience.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Article VI, Division 3 of Section 2-100 of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach, relating to rates of pay and salary schedule be amended by increasing the salary of Lieutenants and Captains as follows:

- (1) All employees will receive an additional 3% general wage adjustment to their 1985-86 base salary.
- (2) That said wage adjustment will effect only those employees who were in the classification of Lieutenant and Captain as of October 1, 1986.

SECTION 2. That said wage increase adjustment shall take effect as of October 1, 1986, as computed and shown on the schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. That the salary schedule for October 1, 1987 relating to rates of pay for Lieutenant and Captain be increased by 3%, as computed and shown on the schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. That the salary schedule for April 1, 1988 relating to rates of pay for Lieutenant and Captain be increased by 3%, as computed and shown on the schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1.8 entitle "General Penlaty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2, Article VI, Division of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach, relating to rates of pay and salary schedule be amended by increasing the salary of certain uniform police employees represented by the Police Benevolent Association Collective Bargaining Agreement as follows:

- (1) All employees, unless otherwise noted herein, will receive at least a 3% general wage adjustment to their 1985-86 base salary.
- (2) The new minimum salary for 1986-87 is \$19,400. Current employees below the new minimum will have their salaries adjusted to the new minimum.
 - (a) current employees whose salaries are adjusted to the new minimum who do not receive 3% more than their 1985-86 salary will have their 1985-86 salary adjusted by 3%.
 - (b) current employees whose salaries are adjusted to the new minimum who received more than 3% of their 1985-86 salary will not be eligible for the 3% general wage increase.
- (3) All employees who have more than three (3) years experience as of October, 1986, with the City of Riviera Beach Police Department as a police officer will receive an additional 3%.

SECTION 2. That said wage increase adjustment shall take effect as of October 1, 1986, as computed and shown on the Schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1.8 entitled "General Penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.




SECTION 1. SECTION 9-16 IS AMENDED IN ITS ENTIRETY AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 9-16. Board of appeals established; method of appeal of Fire Marshal's order established; circuit court appeal of administrative decision provided.

~~A board of appeals is hereby established consisting of five (5) regular members and two (2) alternate members who shall be appointed by the city manager by reason of education, experience, and knowledge, and deemed to be competent to sit in judgement on matters concerning the fire prevention code of the City of Riviera Beach and its enforcement. The members shall serve for a term designated by the city manager. Ord. No. 2360, 11, 12-16-97.~~

- a. The City of Riviera Beach Code Enforcement Board shall sit as the board of appeal that shall render judgement on matters concerning the Fire Prevention Code of the City of Riviera Beach and its enforcement. The conduct of the hearings requirements and procedural due process provided in Riviera Beach Code of Ordinances section 2-35.1 is adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- b. An administrative order of the Fire Marshal, Fire Inspector, or their designee may be appealed by filing a notice of appeal with City of Riviera Beach Codes Enforcement Administrator who shall schedule a hearing of the matter before the board of appeals.
- c. An aggrieved party may appeal a ruling or order of the board of appeal by certiorari to the Circuit Court of the 15th Judicial Circuit in and for Palm Beach County, Florida within thirty (30) days of the execution of the board's written order.

SECTION 2. SECTION 9-17 IS AMENDED TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH BE INCLUDED AS AN ADDITIONAL AMENDMENT TO NFPA 1 3-5.2:

Automatic fire extinguishing systems shall be required for all buildings which are utilized for storage where said storage is in excess of fifteen feet in height, herein after referred to as high piled storage. Such automatic fire extinguishing system requirement shall exist regardless of building height, separation, or gross square footage.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 12 "NUISANCES", OF ORDINANCE NO. 2362 SECTION 2 ENTITLED "CREATION OF NUISANCE ABATEMENT BOARD; CONDUCT OF HEARINGS; POWERS OF NUISANCE ABATEMENT BOARD WITH RESPECT TO PUBLIC NUISANCES", SUBSECTIONS (g)(i)(ii) BY ADDING AND DELETING LANGUAGE FOR CLARIFICATION; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 12 "Nuisances", of Ordinance No. 2362 Section 2 entitled, "Creation of Nuisance Abatement Board; Conduct of Hearings; Powers of Nuisance Abatement Board with Respect to Public Nuisances", is amended such that Section 2.(g) shall provide as follows:

(g) Where the Nuisance Abatement Board closes a building, erection or place pursuant to paragraph (ii) of subdivision (b) of this section, such closing shall be for such period as the Nuisance Abatement Board may direct but in no event shall the closing be for a period of more than one (1) year from the posting of the order pursuant to subdivision (f) of this section. The Nuisance Abatement Board may vacate the provisions of the Order that direct the closing of the building, erection or place if the mortgagee, owner, lessor or lessee shall:

(i) File a surety bond in an amount determined by the Nuisance Abatement Board of which may not exceed the assessed value of the property as determined by the Palm Beach County Property Appraisers Office for the property ordered to be closed and,

(ii) Submit proof to the satisfaction of the Nuisance Abatement Board that the nuisance has been abated and will not be created, maintained or permitted for such period of time as the building, erection or place has been directed to be closed by the order of the Nuisance Abatement Board, then the Nuisance Abatement Board may vacate the provisions of the order that direct the closing of the building, erection or place.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1-8 entitled "General Penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of the Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall be thereby affected.







AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING ARTICLE I ENTITLED "IN GENERAL" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF A COMMUNITY SERVICES ADVISORY BOARD; COMPOSITION, APPOINTMENT, AND TERM; GENERAL PURPOSES AND PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified a need for an advisory board to review and analyze problems in the City of Riviera Beach with regard to the socio-economic and other needs of youth, elderly and other dependent population groups and to make recommendations to the City Council related thereto; and

WHEREAS, it is the City Council's desire that such a board be established to facilitate a comprehensive review of these needs and suggest strategies to alleviate the problems identified.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida:

SECTION I: Article I entitled "In General" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section. Created

- (a) The City Council of the City of Riviera Beach hereby creates a Community Services Advisory Board. The board shall consist of no more than five (5) members with terms of one (1) year commencing in May of each year. A member may be re-appointed for successive terms. An appointment to fill any vacancy on the Community Services Advisory Board shall be for the remainder of the unexpired term of office. If any member fails to attend three (3) successive meetings without prior notice to the chairperson, the Community Services Advisory Board shall declare the member's office vacant and the City Council shall properly fill such vacancy. The members shall serve at the will of the City Council and are removable by the appointing authority upon written notice.
- (b) The City Council shall designate the chairperson of the Community Services Advisory Board. The presence of three (3) or more members shall constitute a quorum of the Community Services Advisory Board. Members shall serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for such travel, mileage and per diem expenses as may be authorized by the City Council in the City's budget.

Section. Created (cont'd)

(c) The board shall act only in an advisory capacity to the City Council. It may develop and recommend a program of community service enhancements and initiatives which shall be presented to the City Council for its action thereon.

SECTION II: Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished as prescribed in Section 1-8 entitled "General Penalty" of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION IV: In the event that any provision or application of the ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall be thereby affected.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 1017, 2242, AND 2304 AND ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN ACCORDANCE WITH FLORIDA STATUTE 163.357. PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida as follows:-

SECTION I

Ordinance Nos. 1017, 2242, and 2304 are hereby repealed in their entirety thereby abolishing the Community Redevelopment Agency created in accordance with Florida Statute 163.356.

SECTION II

In accordance with the provision of Florida Statute 163.357, the City Council declares itself to be Community Redevelopment Agency empowered to transact business and exercise powers as provided for in Part III of Chapter 163 Florida Statutes. This agency shall assume all of the responsibilities and liabilities imposed on or incurred by the previously existing Agency.

SECTION III

The agency shall consist of the five (5) members of the City Council.

SECTION IV

Each commissioner shall serve without compensation for his services, but shall be entitled to the necessary expenses, including travelling expenses, incurred in the discharge of his duties.

SECTION V

If any section, part of a section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this ordinance is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative or void, such holding or invalidity shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance and it shall be construed to have been the legislative intent to pass this ordinance without such unconstitutional, invalid or inoperative part therein and the remainder of this ordinance after the exclusion of such part or parts shall be deemed to be held valid as if such part or parts had not been included therein, or if this ordinance or any of the provisions thereof shall be held inapplicable to any person, group of persons, property, kind of property, circumstances or set of circumstances, such holding shall not affect the applicability thereof to any other person, property or circumstances.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE I, ADDING SECTION 14-4.5 (PREVIOUSLY RESERVED) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA RELATING TO PENSIONS AND RETIREMENT OF FIREMEN: PROVIDING SURVIVORS' BENEFITS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE AND EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. There shall be added to Chapter 14, Article I, of the Code of Ordinances a new section to be numbered 14-4.5 and to read as follows:

Sec. 14-4.5. Survivors' Benefits. Upon death of a member, benefits shall be paid in accordance with this section.

A. Death in line of duty.

(1) For members having less than ten years of credited service. If a member dies from injuries received while in discharge of his duties, leaving a spouse and/or a child or children, the following benefits shall be paid:

(a) a refund of contributions in accordance with Section 14-4.3 to the surviving spouse,

(b) 33 1/3% of the member's total compensation for the year immediately prior to his death to the surviving spouse until her death or remarriage, and

(c) 25% of the member's total compensation for the year immediately prior to his death to a surviving child or children, divided equally, until the last or youngest child marries or attains the age of eighteen (twenty-one if enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university), whichever first occurs.

(2) For members having ten or more years of credited service. If a member dies from injuries received while in discharge of his duties, leaving a spouse and/or a child or children, the following benefits shall be paid:

(a) a refund of contributions in accordance with Section 14-4.3 to the surviving spouse,

(b) the greater of 33 1/3% of the member's total compensation for the year immediately prior to his death or the accrued retirement benefit to the surviving spouse until her death or remarriage, and

(c) 25% of the member's total compensation for the year immediately prior to his death to a surviving child or children until the last or youngest child marries or attains the age of eighteen (twenty-one if enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university), whichever first occurs.

B. Death not in line of duty.

(1) For members having less than ten years of credited service. If a member dies from injuries received not while in discharge of his duties, the following benefits shall be paid: a refund of contributions in accordance with Section 14-4.3 to the surviving spouse or named beneficiary,

(2) For members having ten or more years of credited service. If a member dies from injuries received not while in discharge of his duties, the following benefits shall be paid: the accrued retirement benefit to the member's surviving spouse until death or remarriage or, other named beneficiary for ten years certain.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

Section 3. In the event that any provisions or applications of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications thereof shall not be thereby affected.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 2379

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPHS (1) AND (2) OF SECTION (P) OF CHAPTER 22 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES AND THEREBY INCREASING THE WATER AND SEWER BILLING SECURITY DEPOSITS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

That Subparagraphs (1) and (2) of Section (p) of Chapter 22 of the Code of Ordinances, now reading as follows:

- (p) Billing deposits.*
- (1) For residential single units; [the deposits shall be as follows:]

Meter Size (inches)	Deposit
3/4 or smaller.....	\$36.00
1.....	60.00
1 1/2.....	84.00
2.....	96.00
3.....	120.00
4.....	440.00
Over 4.....	600.00

- (2) All others. Add twenty (20) per cent to the above schedule for all other dwellings and businesses except that the resulting billing deposit shall not be less than three (3) months' minimum water bill as determined from the minimum water rate schedule.

IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

- "(p) Billing Deposits.*
- (1) For each residential unit and each commercial unit the minimum billing security deposit shall be as follows:

3/4" or smaller	40.00	75.00
1"	80.00	111.00
1 1/2"	110.00	312.00

(2) All deposits will be the applicable minimum as stated above, however not less than three (3) months' readiness-to-serve charge plus applicable surcharge if outside the city or under special contract. Commercial account deposits shall equal the applicable minimum as stated above or the sum of the most recent three active billing months (for the service site), whichever is greater. If the site use is changed, the applicable minimum deposit schedule shall be used to calculate the deposit. These deposit requirements shall apply to all new utility accounts opened after _____, 1988. Any customer new or old not paying the previous balance before the turn-off date will be subject to updating their deposit to the new applicable minimum deposit or an amount equal to their last three (3) months' active billing, whichever is greater.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon final passage by the City Council.
