

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA; COUNCIL'S FINDINGS OF FACT; AMENDING SECTION 2-100 ENTITLED "RATES OF PAY" OF DIVISION 3 ENTITLED "SALARY PLAN" OF ARTICLE VI ENTITLED "CITY EMPLOYEES" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY GRANTING UNIFORM COST OF LIVING INCREASES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE (5) PER CENT PER ANNUM TO EMPLOYEES NOT REPRESENTED BY COLLECTIVE BARGAINING OR WHO HAVE SIGNED CONTRACTS WITH THE CITY; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach has held a public hearing and has found and determined an emergency exists and that same can be alleviated by granting a uniform cost of living increase in the amount of five (5) per cent per annum to employees not represented by collective bargaining or employees who have signed contracts with the city.

SECTION 1. That Section 2-100 entitled "Rates of pay" of Division 3 entitled "Salary Plan" of Article VI entitled "City Employees" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances is amended by providing a cost of living increase in the amount of five (5) per cent per annum to employees not represented by collective bargaining or who have signed contracts with the city.

SECTION 2. That said cost of living increase shall take effect as of September 29, 1975, as computed and shown on the Schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict are repealed.



SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.



AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA; COUNCIL'S FINDINGS OF FACT; AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE VI, DIVISION 3 OF SECTION 2-100 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO SALARY PLAN BY ADDING THERETO A SECTION GRANTING AN UNIFORM COST OF LIVING INCREASES TO ALL EMPLOYEES IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE (5) PER CENT; PROVIDING A SAVING CLAUSE; AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach has held a public hearing and has found and determined that an emergency exists and that same can be alleviated by granting an uniform cost of living increase to all employees in the amount of five (5) per cent.

SECTION 1. That Chapter 2 relating to Administration of Article VI relating to City Employees of, Division 3 relating to Salary Plan of Section 2-100 relating to Rates of Pay is amended by adding thereto a section granting an uniform cost of living increase to all employees in the amount of five (5) per cent.

SECTION 2. That said uniform cost of living increase shall go into effect as of September 29, 1975, as computed and shown on the Schedule annexed hereto and made a part of this ordinance.





AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING PARAGRAPHS (A) AND (B) OF SECTION 10-20.6 ENTITLED "FEES" OF DIVISION 1A ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE" OF ARTICLE II ENTITLED "GARBAGE, TRASH, WEEDS AND LITTER" OF CHAPTER 10 ENTITLED "HEALTH AND SANITATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVINGS CLAUSE, PENALTY CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

That Paragraphs (a) and (b) of Section 10-20.6 entitled "Fees of Division 1A entitled "Municipal Refuse Collection Service" of Article II entitled "Garbage, Trash, Weeds and Litter" of Chapter 10 entitled "Health and Sanitation" of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1.

"(A) GROUND LEVEL: AT CURB SIDE OR SWALE AREAS. The fees for collection and disposal of refuse placed for collection at ground level and at curb side or swale area shall be as follows:

(1) RESIDENTIAL UNITS which includes single family residences, duplexes, triplexes, apartments and mobile units shall be charged ~~two-dollars-(\$2.00)~~ two dollars sixty-five cents (\$2.65) per month per living unit.

(2) MOTELS not having container service shall be charged ~~three-dollars-(\$3.00)~~ four dollars (\$4.00) per month for the first unit and ~~one-dollar-seventy-five-cents-(\$1.75)~~ two dollars thirty cents (\$2.30) for each additional unit.

(3) SMALL BUSINESSES AND COMMERCIAL UNITS not having container service and not having over two (2) thirty (30) gallon cans per pickup shall be charged ~~three-dollars-(\$3.00)~~ four dollars (\$4.00) per month.

(4) CONTAINER SERVICE rates shall be as follows:

Note: When multiple residence units, excluding motels, use container service, the charge will be the residential unit rate or the container rate, whichever is higher."

SECTION 2.

"(B) It shall be the responsibility of the person designated in (section) 10-19 above to provide for the removal of any appliances, couches, chairs, beds, or like items. If the City is requested to remove such items, the request shall be made in person at the office of the city clerk and shall pay the following charges at that time:

Removal of one item.\$2.50	<u>\$3.25</u>
For each additional item\$2.25	<u>\$3.00</u>

If such items are not removed, by the person designated, he or she shall be subject to the penalties as prescribed by Section 10-34 of the Code of Ordinances of Riviera Beach."

SECTION 3.

This ordinance shall take effect on November 1, 1975 at 12:01 A.M.

SECTION 4.

Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict are repealed.

SECTION 5.

Should any part or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION 6.

Each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as provided in Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 7.

Specific authority is granted to codify this ordinance.

SECTION 8.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The legislative body may from time to time designate and appoint a qualified person as city treasurer of the city, which office of city treasurer is hereby created and the finance director is hereby divested of the duties of treasurer. This section shall be designated as section 2-35, entitled "Office of city treasurer created; appointment; divesting finance director of duties of treasurer." in the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2. The powers and duties of the city treasurer shall be:

- a. The city treasurer shall deposit all monies received by the city in the account of the treasurer in such depositories as are qualified by the State of Florida for the deposit of public funds and it shall be the responsibility of the treasurer to secure from such depository security for all funds on deposit.
- b. The city treasurer shall sign all checks along with the Mayor in payment of the debts of the city as are approved by the city council and the director of finance.
- c. The city treasurer shall be responsible for the arranging of both short and long term financing as approved by the City Council and City Manager.
- d. The city treasurer shall at all times keep unused funds of the city invested in interest bearing accounts in such securities as are authorized by the State of Florida.
- e. The city treasurer shall perform such other duties as are assigned to him or her by the City Council or City Manager.

f. The city treasurer shall give bond, the premium on which shall be paid by the city in such an amount as required by the City Council and with surety to do business in the State of Florida. The bond shall be conditioned upon the faithful performance of the duties of office, and to indemnify the city for any loss due to any neglect of duty or wrongful act on the part of the city treasurer.

This section shall be designated as section 2-36, entitled "Powers and duties of city treasurer" in the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. Paragraph (b) of Section 2-33 entitled "Office of Finance director created; appointment; offices combined" of Article III. entitled "Finance Director and Treasurer" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances which reads:

"(b) The finance director shall also be the city treasurer" is repealed.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 5. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance is held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and application thereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 6. Specific authority is granted to codify this ordinance.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.


