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ORDINANCE NO. 1101

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA, EXTENDING THE TERRITORIAL LIMITS OF RIVIERA BEACH BY THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS UNINCORPORATED LANDS, LYING WITHIN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 171-74 FLORIDA STATUTES AS AMENDED JULY 1, 1975.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, has heretofore determined the necessity to annex certain properties lying adjacent and contiguous to the territorial limits of Riviera Beach, and within Palm Beach County, and is used for "Urban Purposes", and WHEREAS, the annexation of subject properties is in accordance with the Comprehensive Development Plan of the City of Riviera Beach, WHEREAS, all requirements of the Charter and Ordinances of Riviera Beach, Florida, and the laws of the State of Florida, relative to annexation have been complied with,

BE AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. That the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, hereby annexes to its territorial limits that unincorporated tract of land situated in Township 42 South, Range 43 East, of the Tallahassee Meridian, which is described as follows:

A parcel of land situated in Township 42 South, Range 43 East, of the Tallahassee Meridian, and described as follows: Beginning at the Southwest corner of Section 32 of said Township and Range; thence northerly along the west line of said Section 32 to the southerly right-of-way line of State Road 710, as same is shown on plat recorded in Road Plat Book 3, pages 151 thru 160, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida; thence westerly along said southerly right-of-way of State Road 710 to a point 340 ft. more or less easterly of the easterly right-of-way line of the Central and Southern Florida Flood Control District Canal C-17 as now laid out and in use; thence southerly on a course whose included angle is 270° as measured counter-clockwise from the east to the south, a distance of 575.0 ft. more or less to a point on a line 50.0 ft. northeasterly of, when measured at right angles, and parallel with the northeasterly right of way line of

the Seaboard Coastline Railroad; thence northwesterly along the said parallel line a distance of 375 ft. more or less to a point on the east right of way line of Canal C-17 (A works of the Central and Southern Florida Flood Control District) as now laid out and in use; thence northerly along said easterly right-of-way line of Canal C-17 to the north line of the south half of Section 30, Township 42 South, Range 43 East, thence easterly along said north line of the South half of Section 30 to a point 667.61 feet westerly from the east one-quarter corner of Section 30; thence northerly making an angle with the preceding course of $91^{\circ} 00' 46''$ from east to north, a distance of 652.99 feet; thence easterly making an angle with the preceding course of $89^{\circ} 54' 57''$ from South to East, a distance of 667.87 feet to the east line of said Section 30; thence northerly along the east line of Section 30 to the Northeast corner of said Section 30; thence westerly along the north line of said Section 30 to the west right-of-way line of Interstate 95 (I-95); thence southerly along said west right-of-way line of I-95 to its point of intersection with the south line of said Township 42 south; thence from said point of intersection, easterly along said Township line to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That, the territorial limits of the City of Riviera Beach are hereby redefined to include the above described property.

Section 3. That, all City ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That, subject property upon annexation shall be zoned in accordance with the Zoning Code of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, subject to compliance with the provisions of Section 171.062, Florida Statutes.

Section 5. That, each of the provisions of this ordinance are separable and if any section, subsection, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid by any Court of Law of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions shall not be affected but shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. That, the present ordinance shall be become effective only upon approval by the majority of the registered electors of both the City of Riviera Beach and the area to be annexed voting separately, in accordance with Section 171.0413(2)(3)(4) Florida Statutes.

Section 7. That, the referendum on the annexation of said properties shall take place on April 6, Said referendum shall be published at least once a week for the four consecutive weeks immediately proceeding the date of referendum; said referendum shall be carried out in the form and manner set out in Section 171.0413 (4)(5)(6), Florida Statutes

Section 8. That, upon effectuation of this ordinance the charter boundary article shall be revised to incorporate changes in the municipal boundaries of the City of Riviera Beach which shall embrace and include all that territory in Palm Beach County, Florida, described as follows, to wit:

"Beginning at the point of intersection of the west right-of-way line of I-95 and the north line of Section 30, Township 42 South, Range 43 East, of the Tallahassee Meridian, thence East along the North Lines of said Section 30, Section 29 Section 28, and Section 27 of the said Township and Range to the centerline of the Intercoastal Waterway; thence northerly along said centerline to a point of intersection with a line parallel to and 1,294 feet south of the north line of Section 22 and the centerline of the Intercoastal Waterway; thence East along said line parallel to and 1,294 feet south of the north line of said Section 22 to a point in the westerly boundary of the submerged land area conveyed by the Trustees of the Internal Improvement Fund of the State of Florida to the Lake Worth Realty Company, a Florida Corporation by Trustee's Deed No. 17146 recorded in Deed Book 205, page 82 Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida; thence northerly

along said westerly boundary to a point of intersection with a line parallel to and 8,000 feet southerly from, measured at right angles to the north line of Section 10; thence easterly along said line parallel to and 8,000 feet southerly from, measured at right angles to the north line of Section 10; thence easterly along said line parallel to and 8,000 feet south of the north line of said Section 10 to the water's edge of the Atlantic Ocean; thence southerly along the water's edge of the Atlantic Ocean to the point of intersection with the southerly line of a tract of land in Palm Beach County known as Replat of Yacht Harbor, as the same is shown on plat recorded in Plat Book 23, page 57, of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida; thence continuing southerly along the water's edge of the Atlantic Ocean to a point in a line 1,000 feet south of measured at right angles to, the south line of said Replat of Yacht Harbor; thence on a true west line and parallel to the south line of said Replat of Yacht Harbor to a point in the southerly extension of the center line of that part of State Road No. 703 (formerly State Road No. 140) which runs northerly and southerly through said Replat of Yacht Harbor; thence continuing on the same course west 1,539 feet; thence along along a line with a bearing of north $88^{\circ}-03'-30''$ west to its intersection with the centerline of the channel of the Intercoastal Waterway, as now established; thence southwesterly and southerly along said channel centerline to the south line of said Township 42 South, Range 43 East; thence Westerly along said Township line to the point of intersection of intersection of the south line of said Township 42 with the west right-of-way line of Interstate 95(I-95), thence northerly along said west right-of-way line of I-95 to the point of the beginning.

Section 9. That, this ordinance shall become effective on December 31, 1976 subject to adoption on separate vote, by the majority of the registered electors in Riviera Beach and in the subject property, and in accordance with the law.



AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 4-24 ENTITLED "RESTRICTIONS ON ISSUANCE OF LICENSES IN CERTAIN AREAS, HOURS OF SALE." OF ARTICLE II. ENTITLED "MISCELLANEOUS RESTRICTIONS" OF CHAPTER 4 ENTITLED "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ENACTING SUBSECTION (1) EXEMPTING 4 COP LICENSES FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (a), (b) AND (c) OF SECTION 4-24, PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 4-24 entitled "Restrictions on issuance of licenses in certain areas, hours of sale " of Article II entitled "Miscellaneous Restrictions" of Chapter 4 entitled "Alcoholic Beverages" of the Code of Ordinances is amended by enacting subsection (1) which reads as follows:

"(1) The provisions of subsections (a), (b) and (c) of this section shall not apply to 4 COP licenses issued by the division of beverage of the department of business regulation."

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment for a period of time not exceeding sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this ordinance.






ENTITLED "IN GENERAL" OF CHAPTER 16 ENTITLED "RECREATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REGULATING THE USE OF METAL DETECTORS ON THE PUBLIC BEACHES OF THE MUNICIPALITY, PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 16-4. entitled "Beaches— Rules of conduct." of Article I. entitled "In General" of Chapter 16 entitled "Recreation" of the Code of Ordinances be amended by adding thereto the following subsection to read:

"(9) No metal dector shall be permitted upon the public beaches of the municipality, except for the search of lost objects of value between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) a.m. and ten o'clock (10:00) a.m., inclusive and four o'clock (4:00) p.m. and five o'clock (5:00) p.m., inclusive, and upon approval of the city manager, first after written application is made by the person losing such object of value stating therein the approximate date, time and location when and where the loss occurred and describing the object sought to be found and its value.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, shall be punished as provided in Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this ordinance.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That subsection (a) entitled "Vacation leave" of Section 2.112. entitled "Vacation and holiday leave; limitations; records for earned time, leaves of absence, etc." of Division 3 entitled "Salary Plan" of Article VI entitled "City Employees" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" is repealed in part as follows:

"Sec. 2.112. Vacation and holiday leave; limitations; records for earned time, leaves of absence, etc.

(a) Vacation leave. A leave of absence with pay will be earned as vacation leave at the rate of one day for each full month of service. Vacation leave may be granted to any employee with permanent status. The time at which vacation will be granted shall be at the discretion of the department head in a manner which will prevent any loss of vacation privilege to the employee. ~~Employees with more than five (5) years of service shall earn vacation at the following rate:~~

6-years-of-service	13-days
7-years-of-service	14-days
8-years-of-service	15-days

~~Fifteen (15) days shall be the maximum annual vacation leave which may be accrued by any employee. Additional leave without pay may be granted to employees at the discretion of the department head, with the approval of the city manager. If any employee should, for some cause approved by the city manager in advance, not take his earned vacation time within the twelve (12) month period following its accrual, the city manager may either allow the lost time or pay the employee for such time.~~

Employees shall accrue paid vacation credit at their straight time rate during active pay status on the following basis:

Vacation leave shall accrue at the rate of one (1) day for each full month of service as scheduled above.

SECTION 2. That subsection (c) entitled "Limitations" of Section 2.112. entitled "Vacation and holiday leave; limitations; records for earned time, leaves of absence, etc." of Division 3 entitled "Salary Plan" of Article VI entitled "City employees" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the code of Ordinances which reads:

~~"(a)-Limitations---Accrued-vacation-leave shall-not-exceed-twenty-four-(24)-days."~~

is repealed, and in lieu thereof the following section shall be inserted:

"(c) Limitations. The maximum annual vacation leave which may be accrued by any employee is as follows:

This Section does not apply to animal hospitals as set forth in Section 5-5 and 5-6 of this Code.

Sec. 5-4.1. Keeping of livestock and poultry prohibited. EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1110

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, DECLARING COUNCIL'S FINDINGS; AMENDING CHAPTER 13 ENTITLED "OFFENSES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ADDING A SECTION PROHIBITING UNAUTHORIZED CONNECTION OR INTERFERENCE WITH ANY PART OF THE CATV FRANCHISE SYSTEM WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, hereby declares and determines that in order to provide for the public health, welfare, safety and commonwealth of the city in prohibiting unauthorized connection or interference with any part of the CATV franchise system within the city, necessitates the enactment of this ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to accept any unauthorized connection, whether physically, electrically, inductively or otherwise, with any part of a franchise CATV system within this city for the purpose of taking or receiving television signals, radio signals, pictures, programs or sound.

SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to make any unauthorized connection, whether physically, electrically, acoustically, inductively or otherwise, with any part of a franchised CATV system within this city for the purpose of enabling himself or others to receive any television signal, radio signal, picture, program or sound, without payment to the owner of said system.

SECTION 3. It shall be unlawful for any person, without the consent of the owner, to wilfully tamper with, remove or in ure any cables, wires or equipment used for distribution of television signals, radio signals, pictures, programs or sound.

SECTION 4. Each day's violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as provided in Section 1-8 of the Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 5. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, to the extent of such conflict are repealed.

SECTION 6. Should any part or provision of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

SECTION 7. Specific authority is granted to codify this ordinance.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adopted by the City Council.



Members shall hold office at the will of the legislative body and are removable by the appointing authority upon written notice. Members shall serve without compensation. The members shall adopt rules and regulations for the conduct of their affairs."

WHEREAS, the City Council desiring to commemorate the significance of the Bicentennial Year of celebration by insuring the preservation of the Historic Oak Tree situated on Avenue "C" near 10th Street east of Tropical Court, 67 East 11th Street, Lots 3 through 7 inclusive, Block 25, Riviera Subdivision, Riviera Beach, Florida, as more explicitly shown on Exhibit "A" attached to this ordinance and made a part hereof, and

WHEREAS, the historic pedigree of this graceful oak tree is as follows:

This is one of the oak trees which gave the name Oak Lawn to the area now known as Riviera Beach. In 1882 Allen E. Heyser purchased 80 acres here for \$500. He built a 22 room hotel on the lakefront at what is now 10th Street. The hotel was named "The OakLawn House" because of the five "monster" oaks on the fine lawn. Heyser was the first lawyer and the first County Judge in Dade County (now Palm Beach and Dade Counties). The Oak Lawn Post Office was established at the hotel in 1889 and the neighborhood as far north as the present Blue Heron Bridge was called Oak Lawn. Early settlers of Oak Lawn included Emmanuel Heyser (the Judge's Father), Josiah Sherman, Willie Melton, Jacob Guildersleeve, Thomas M. Taylor and Ed. Cain. In 1893, Judge Heyser changed the name of the Post Office and the Hotel to Riviera after a visitor, usually thought to be a journalist from Atlanta, described the area as the Riviera of America. In 1900 C. N. Newcomb bought the Riviera Hotel and converted it into a summer home where he and his family lived for many years. Newcomb laid out the plan for the original townsite of Riviera in 1913. He envisioned his home as a clubhouse for residents; but this never came about and the former Oak Lawn House was torn down in the 1930's.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

That Section 13.2.1. entitled "Abandoned, wrecked or junked vehicles; unlawful to leave on public streets or private property", of Chapter 13 entitled "Offenses" of the Code of Ordinances is amended by adding a new section after subsection (g) to be entitled "Supplemental Regulations Adopted" which is to read:

"Supplemental regulations adopted. That section 705.16 (Abandoned Property), Florida Statutes is adopted as a supplemental and cumulative procedure to this section. Three (3) copies of section 705.16, Florida Statutes, are filed with the Clerk of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, in his office, available for public use, inspection and examination".

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment for a period of time not exceeding sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.




AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBPARAGRAPH 5 OF SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 20-22 ENTITLED "SPEED RESTRICTIONS" OF DIVISION 1 ENTITLED "IN GENERAL" OF ARTICLE 11 ENTITLED "OPERATION OF VEHICLES" OF CHAPTER 20 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY ESTABLISHING CERTAIN SPEED ZONES THROUGHOUT THE CITY, PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be subject to the penalties provided for in Transition Rule 20, Florida Rules of Practice and Procedure for Traffic Courts.

SECTION 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment for a period of time not exceeding sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 6. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.






