ORDINANCE NO. 1120

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SUBSECTION (b) OF SECTION 10-20 10 ENTITLED "TREE TRUNKS, LIMBS AND OTHER DEBRIS-PLACING OR DEPOSITING ON STREETS, ETC., PROHIBITED, EXCEPTIONS", OF DIVISION 1A ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE" OF ARTICLE 11 ENTITLED "GARBAGE, TRASH, WEEDS AND LITTER" OF CHAPTER 10 ENTITLED "HEALTH AND SANITATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY DELETING A PART THEREOF, PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That subsection (b) of Section 10-20 10 entitled "Tree trunks, limbs and other debris-placing or depositing on streets etc., prohibited, exceptions", of Division 1A entitled "Municipal Refuse Collection Service" of Article 11 entitled "Garbage, Trash, Weeds and Litter" of Chapter 10 entitled "Health and Sanitation" is amended to read:

"(b) Any sweepings, leaves, debris and trash resulting from ordinary trimming, care and upkeep of lawns, yards, shrubs, trees and hedges shall be deposited for collection in sturdy, suitable containers or boxes at curb side or swale area or in places designated therefor by the city. Tree trunks and limbs resulting from ordinary trimming, care and upkeep may be deposited for collection and shall not exceed one hundred (100) pounds and four (4) feet in length. Papers, rags, magazines and the like may be deposited for collection in the places provided in this paragraph provided that they are securely tied in bundles not exceeding sixty (60) pounds in weight, or provided such matter is stored in sturdy containers which will, in all ordinary weather conditions, prevent such matter from being scattered about by the elements or animals. Any or all of the matter permitted under this paragraph is to be placed on the property owned or occupied by the person depositing the same, ~~or if placed on property of others the written consent of the other owners tenant or person in possession of such property of such others.~~ Nothing herein shall be construed to permit the placing of tree trunks or limbs resulting from the falling or removal of large trees or large numbers of trees or from the clearing of lots or other areas".

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine not

not exceeding five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment for a period of time not exceeding sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council.

ORDINANCE NO. 1121

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION 6 ENTITLED "SALE AT NOT LESS THAN 98%." OF ARTICLE VIII ENTITLED "BONDS" OF THE CITY'S CHARTER BY PROVIDING BOND ISSUES LESS THAN \$500,000 FACE VALUE MAY BE SOLD ON A NEGOTIATED OR PRIVATE SALE BASIS; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 6 entitled "Sale <sup>A</sup>t Not Less Than 98%." of Article VIII entitled "Bonds" of the City's Charter is amended to read:

"Section 6. SALE AT NOT LESS THAN 98%. That the said City shall not sell any bonds issued by it in the future for less than ninety-eight percent (98%) of the face value thereof ; and that ~~all bonds which the city may sell shall be sold to the lowest bidder for cash after notice of the city's intention to sell~~ Any bond issue of \$500,000 or more face value shall be sold to the bidder providing the lowest net interest cost to the city for cash only after at least ten (10) days notice to bidders of such sale has been published in a newspaper published in Palm Beach County, Florida, and having a circulation within the City of Riviera Beach, and a financial newspaper in New York City at least ten (10) days prior to the sale of such bonds; but, in no event, shall a sale be made at a price less than the highest bidder more than the lowest net interest cost to the city or best bid which shall have been received considering all the circumstances. The city shall have the power to reject any and all such bids. Bond issues of less than \$500,000 face value may be sold on a negotiated or private sale basis; provided however, that at least three (3) proposals as to interest rate and term must be first secured."

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adoption by the City Council and upon being filed with the department of state.




AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, FIXING THE VALUATION OF REAL PROPERTY AND TANGIBLE BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY; LEVYING A TAX ON REAL PROPERTY AND TANGIBLE BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY LOCATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY FOR THE YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1976; FIXING THE MILLAGE RATE THEREON FOR SAID YEAR; ADOPTING A FISCAL BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1976-1977; APPROPRIATING THE VARIOUS SUMS SET OUT IN THE FISCAL BUDGET; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. That for the year ending December 31, 1976, the valuation on all real property and tangible business personal property within the City of Riviera Beach is hereby determined to be and is fixed as follows:

- (a) Real Property and Tangible Business Personal Property on which tax can be extended, exclusive of homestead property, \$296,029,853.

Subject to final approval of the County Equalization Board.

SECTION 2. For the year ending December 31, 1976, a tax of nine (9) mills on the dollar shall be, and is hereby levied and shall be collected on all real property and tangible business personal property within the City of Riviera Beach, Florida, not specifically designated as homestead property or owned by the municipality and/or expressly exempted by the laws of the Constitution of the State of Florida for the purpose of raising funds for the improvements and government of the City, and for the payment of its obligations and expenses, and for the purpose of carrying out the purposes and duties granted and imposed by the City Charter. Said real property and tangible business personal property being specifically set forth as item (a) in Section 1 hereof and valued in the amount of \$296,029,853 subject to final approval of the County Equalization Board.

SECTION 3. The items and figures as shown on the attached Budget of Income and Expenditures for the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, Exhibit 1 shall be and the same are hereby


adopted as the Budget for the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, for the year 1976-1977 and the various respective sums shown therein are hereby appropriated for the purposes set out.

SECTION 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, hereby declares and determines that in order to provide for the public health, welfare, safety and commonwealth of the City, that this amendment to the Code of Ordinances should be enacted; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and the Department of Community Development and Environmental Control have reviewed the necessity of this amendment and approved same,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. Paragraph (A) of Section 10-20.6 entitled "Fees" of Division 1A entitled "Municipal Refuse Collection Service" of Article II entitled "Garbage, Trash, Weeds and Litter" of Chapter 10 entitled "Health and Sanitation" of the Code of Ordinances is amended to read:

"(A) GROUND LEVEL: AT CURB SIDE OR SWALE AREA. The fees for collection and disposal of refuse placed for collection at ground level and at curb side or swale area shall be as follows:

- (1) RESIDENTIAL UNITS which includes single family residences, duplexes, triplexes, apartments and mobile units shall be charged ~~two-dollars sixty-five-cents-(\$2.65)~~ three dollars seventy-five cents (\$3.75) per month per living unit.
- (2) MOTELS not having container service shall be charged ~~four-dollars-(\$4.00)~~ three dollars twenty-five cents (\$3.25) per month ~~for-the-first-unit and-two-dollars-thirty-cents-(\$2.30)-for-each additional~~ per unit.
- (3) SMALL BUSINESSES AND COMMERCIAL UNITS not having container service and not having over two (2) thirty (30) gallon cans per pickup shall be charged four dollars (\$4.00) per month.
- (4) CONTAINER SERVICE rates shall be as follows:

- (5) COMMERCIAL UNITS WITH OWN COMPACTION any customer that has its own compaction the container rate shall be charged double the normal container rate.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction, be subject to pay a fine not exceeding five hundred (\$500.00) dollars or imprisonment for a period of time not exceeding sixty (60) days or both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this ordinance.





EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1125

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, CITY COUNCIL'S FINDINGS OF FACT, AMENDING SECTION 107.5 ENTITLED "BUILDING PERMIT VALUATIONS" OF SECTION 6-1 ENTITLED "SOUTHERN STANDARD BUILDING CODE - ADOPTION BY REFERENCE; AMENDMENTS." OF ARTICLE I ENTITLED "IN GENERAL" OF CHAPTER 6 ENTITLED "BUILDINGS" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY REVISING THE BUILDING PERMIT VALUATIONS SCHEDULE; PROVIDING A PENALTY CLAUSE, REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida, hereby declares and determines that in order to provide for the public health, welfare, safety and commonwealth of the City, that this revision of the building permit valuations schedule to the Code of Ordinances should be enacted as an emergency ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Department Building and the Department of Community Development and Environmental Control have reviewed the necessity of this revision and approved same.





AND PARAGRAPH (1) ENTITLED "MEMBER CONTRIBUTIONS" OF SECTION 2-120.5 ENTITLED "CONTRIBUTIONS" OF DIVISION 4 ENTITLED "GENERAL PENSION PLAN" OF ARTICLE VI ENTITLED "CITY EMPLOYEES" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY INCREASING THE MONTHLY RETIREMENT BENEFIT AND CONTRIBUTION; PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That paragraph (a) of subsection (1) entitled "Normal retirement benefit" of Section 2-120.4 entitled "Retirement Benefits." of Division 4 entitled "General Pension Plan." of Article VI entitled "City Employees" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances be amended to read:

"Sec. 2-120.4 Retirement benefits.

(1) Normal retirement benefit.

(a) Amount. The monthly retirement benefit shall be an amount equal to ~~one-and-one-half~~ two per cent ~~(1½%)~~ (2%) of the average monthly earnings as defined in section 2-120.1 for each year of service, provided, however, that no member shall be entitled to accrue a retirement benefit greater than seventy per cent (70%) of average monthly earnings in any event.

No benefit shall be payable for any period of time during which an eligible employee has failed to elect and apply for coverage under the plan."

SECTION 2. That paragraph (1) entitled "Member contributions." of Section 2-120.5 entitled "Contributions" of Division 4 entitled "General Pension Plan." of Article VI entitled "City Employees" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances be amended to read:

"Sec. 2-120.5 Contributions.

(1) Member contributions. Members of the retirement system shall make regular contributions to the trust fund at a rate equal to ~~three-per-cent-(3%)~~ five per cent (5%) of their respective annual earnings. Eligible employees, as a condition of membership, shall agree in writing upon becoming a member to make the contributions specified herein. Said contributions shall be deducted from said earnings before the same are paid."

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances or charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict, repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or application of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the other provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 1. That the following Sections of Article 1 relating to Water of Chapter 22, relating to Water and Sewer of the Code of Ordinances are amended to read as follows:

Section 22-5. entitled "Chapter constitutes agreement" is amended by adding the following paragraphs which read:

"All charges and regulations are governed by ordinances, resolutions and agreements with the Bondholders as adopted by the City Council and are subject to modifications or changes as determined by the City Council.

The charge for trash and garbage collection shall be billed as part of the water and sewer service billing and is subject to the same terms of payment as provided for in this Chapter."






AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, ABOLISHING THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, FLORIDA, EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 30, 1976 AT 4:00 P.M., REPEALING ARTICLE VI ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL COURT" OF THE CHARTER AND REPEALING ARTICLE IV ENTITLED "MUNICIPAL COURT" OF CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, PROVIDING A REPEALING CLAUSE, SAVING CLAUSE, AUTHORITY TO CODIFY, AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Riviera Beach, by Resolution No. 116-76, passed and adopted on August 4, 1976, certified its intention to abolish its Municipal Court effective November 30, 1976, at 4:00 P.M. to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida and requested permission from the Chief Justice of the Florida Supreme Court to abolish its Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida did grant permission on September 10, 1976, under Case No. 50,031;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVIERA BEACH, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the Municipal Court of the City of Riviera Beach, Florida be and the same stands abolished as of November 30, 1976, at 4:00 P.M.

SECTION 2. That on November 30, 1976, at 4:00 P.M. Article VI entitled "Municipal Court" the Charter be and same stands repealed.

SECTION 3. That on November 30, 1976, at 4:00 P.M. Article IV entitled "Municipal Court" of Chapter 2 entitled "Administration" of the Code of Ordinances be and the same repealed.

SECTION 4. That a certified copy of this Ordinance be mailed to:

Hon. Ben F. Overton, Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Florida.

Hon. Thomas E. Sholts, Chief Judge of the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, Palm Beach County, Florida

Hon. John B. Dunkle, Clerk of the Circuit Court of the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit, Palm Beach County, Florida.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances or Charter provisions in conflict herewith are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

SECTION 6. In the event that any provision or application of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, it is the legislative intent that the provisions and applications hereof shall not be thereby affected.

SECTION 7. Specific authority is hereby granted to codify this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its final passage and adopted by the City Council.


