The Excellence in Education Award was started with the object of raising the prestige of Professionals and Para-Professionals and giving public recognition to the meritorious services of outstanding persons working in Elementary, Middle and High Schools within the City of Riviera Beach. This award will be presented annually.

The Martin Luther King (MLK) Awards nominating Committee will review the submitted nomination forms and present one top category nominee for each school to the Riviera Beach City Council. The City Council will select an ‘Excellence in Education Award’ based upon the following criteria:

- Minimum of 2 years employment with a school in the City of Riviera Beach.
- Has made a positive difference in the lives of students.
- Has shown a willingness to work with our Riviera Beach students.
- Has demonstrated enthusiasm about our students, our schools, and our community,
- Continually toward the betterment of their school and community.
- Demonstrates and embodies honesty and integrity in their service.

In choosing the recipient, consideration will be given to the nominee’s achievements during the most recent completed school year along with their past achievements and ongoing contributions to the Riviera Beach community and schools.

To be eligible, the person must be an employee of a school located within the Riviera Beach city limits.

Nominees shall not be required to live in the City of Riviera Beach. The school administrator must sign off on all applications. An individual can only be nominated for one service award. Retired teachers are not eligible for the award unless they served a part of the nomination period school year.

Previous award winners are ineligible. However, those who were previously nominated but did not receive awards, may be re-nominated. Only individuals may be nominated – not groups or organizations or an employee. Self-nominations or incomplete nomination forms will not be considered. The number of nominations received per nominee will bear no weight in the selection for Excellence in Education Award.

HOW TO NOMINATE: If you feel an Educator, Administrator, or Faculty member of a Riviera Beach School has given unselfishly to help Riviera Beach Students and or meets the above criteria, please complete the Official City of Riviera Beach Nomination Form (copy attached). Completed forms must also be signed off by the Administrator of the school the nominee serves. Additional Nomination Forms may be picked up at Riviera Beach City Hall – 600 W. Blue Heron Boulevard – during regular city business hours – Monday through Friday, 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
