### VOTE-BY-MAIL

**REQUEST IT** Visit [VotePalmBeach.gov](http://VotePalmBeach.gov), call (561) 656-6208, or email [votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov](mailto:votebymail@votepalmbeach.gov)  
*Deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot to be mailed to you is October 23 at 5:00 p.m.  
A ballot can be requested in person until November 1.*

*Please have your Driver License, Florida ID card, or the last 4 digits of your Social Security number available when making your request.*

**RETURN IT** Mail it using pre-paid postage or drop off your Vote-by-Mail ballot:  
**October 23 - October 31** at designated drop off locations across the county, including all of the county's Special Election Early Voting locations and 4 SOE office locations.

*\*\*Your ballot must be received at the Main Elections Office by 7:00 p.m. on Election Day, November 2, 2021. \*\**

change your party is October 4, 2021**
