For the best view of the parade, make sure to arrive early and grab a focal spot. The Parade viewing stand will be located at Avenue P and MLK Blvd. The entire route will allow viewers to witness the vibrant colors, lively performances, and the community spirit that make this parade exciting, enjoyable and so special.

Following the parade, join us at the Dan Calloway Park for the post-parade festivities from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. This family-friendly event will be a great opportunity to spend quality time with family and friends while celebrating the legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
